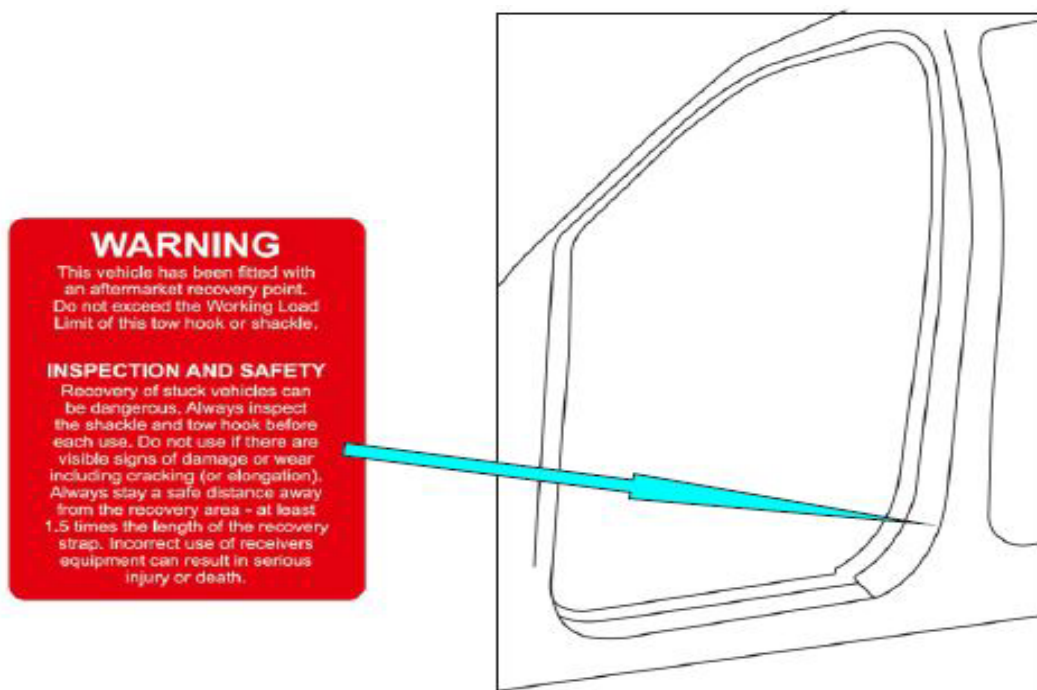
Do not exceed the Working Load Limit of these recovery points or shackle.

INSPECTION AND SAFETY

Recovery of stuck vehicles can be dangerous. Always inspect the shackle and recovery points before each use. Do not use if there are visible signs of damage or wear including cracking (or elongation). Always stay a safe distance away from the recovery area - at least 1.5 times the length of the recovery strap. Incorrect use of receivers equipment can result in serious injury or death.

Always use recovery points as a matched pair teamed with an equalising bridle during any recovery situation.

- * Personal safety during the installation process must be adhered to at all times and the use.
- * Estimated time for installation: 30 minutes.
- * The RIVAL Recovery points must be mounted and affixed to the vehicle according to this installation manual of personal safety equipment is highly recommended.
- * Do not install this Recovery points on vehicle models other than those allowed in this manual.
- * Check state and local highway safety laws regarding permitted recovery points types.

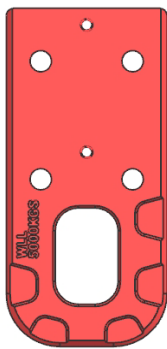
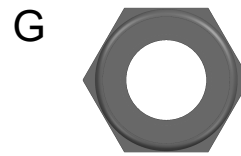
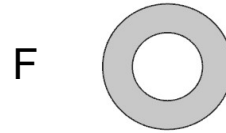
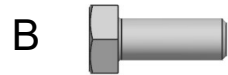
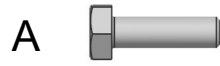

- * M12 - 77 N·m

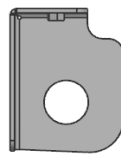

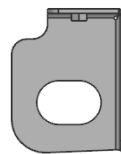

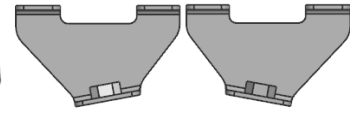

INSTALLATION PROCEDURE

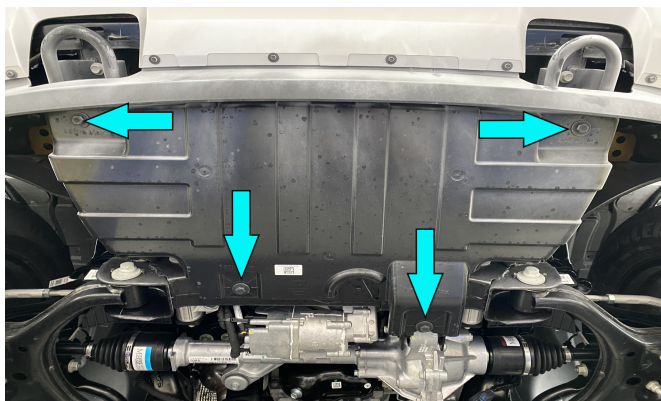

1. Unscrew OE bolts and remove OE plate (fig.1).

*** Set aside for re-use later on.**

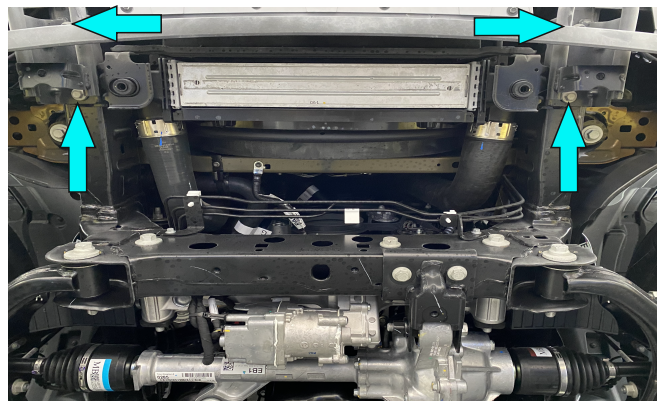

2. Fix intercooler using transmission jack, unscrew OE bolts after that and remove OE recovery points (fig.2)

*** Set aside for re-use later on.**

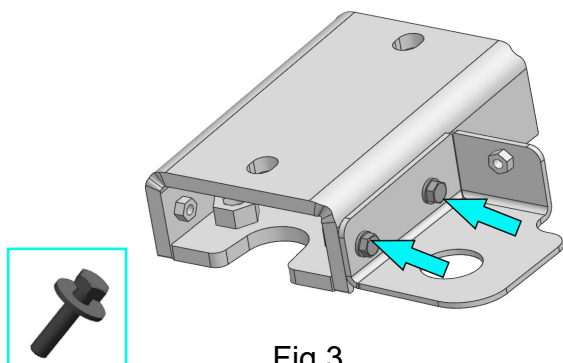

3. Install intercooler bracket (item J) on recovery point bracket (item I) and fix using bolts M6x20, washers 6 (item A, D) (fig.3).

***Tighten hardware after that.**

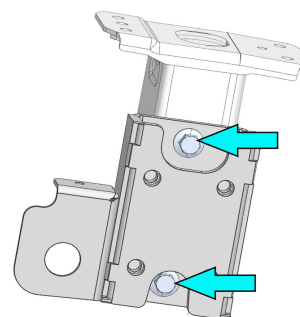

4. Install recovery point bracket (item I) on the left side of the vehicle and fix using OE bolts as shown in fig.4.

***Tighten hardware after that.**

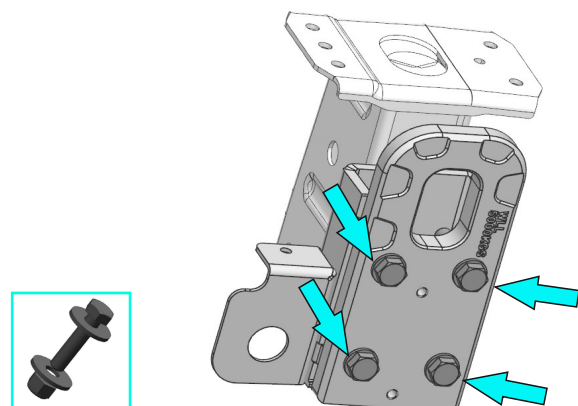

5. Install recovery point (item H) on recovery point bracket (item I) and fix using bolts M12x50, washers 12, nuts M12 (item C, F, G) (fig.5).

***Tighten hardware after that.**

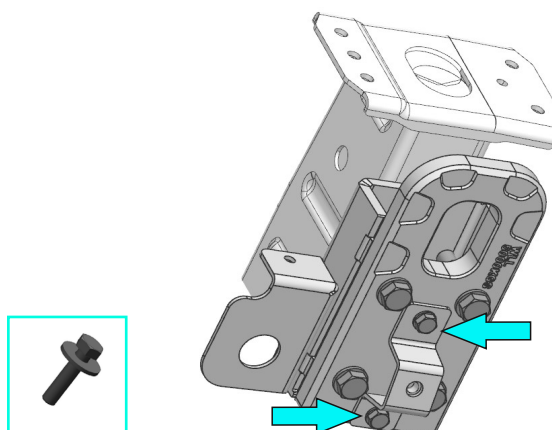

6. Install bash plate bracket (item L) on recovery point (item H) **for Ranger and Everest**. Fix using bolts M8x20, washers 8 (item B, E) (fig.6).

***Tighten hardware after that.**

INSTALLATION PROCEDURE

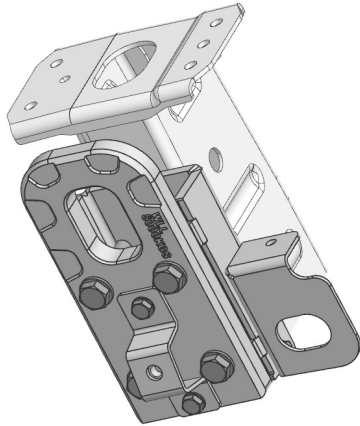

7. Similarly install on the right side of vehicle (**Ranger and Everest**) (fig.7).

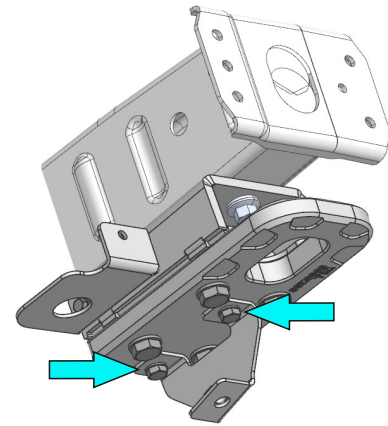

8. Install left bash plate bracket (item M) on recovery point (item H) **for Ranger Raptor**. Fix using bolts M8x20, washers 8 (item B, E) (fig.8).

***Tighten hardware after that.**

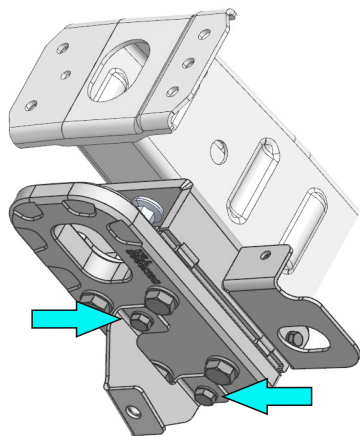

9. Install right bash plate bracket (item N) on recovery point (item H) **for Ranger Raptor**. Fix using bolts M8x20, washers 8 (item B, E) (fig.9).

***Tighten hardware after that.**

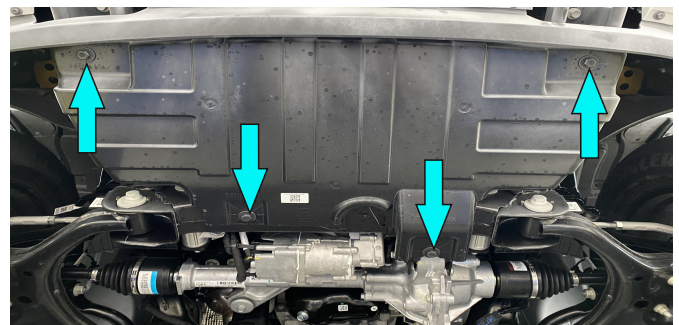

10. Install OE plate and fix it using OE hardware (fig.10).

INSTALLATION PROCEDURE



Before operating a vehicle fitted with RIVAL Recovery Points 2D.1817.2:

- make sure all fittings are tightened
- check winch operation
- check that all electrical wiring is attached to the lights
